VISIT JAX TRACK at HODGES STADIUM FACILITY

Only 1/4" or smaller pyramid spikes are allowed. Fully Automatic Timing & results will be done using FinishLynx Cameras interfaced with Hy-Tek Meet Manager. PARKING

SPECTATOR SEATING

Spectators MUST UTILIZE designated seating areas and <u>will not</u> be allowed in the competition area. Anyone on the field without a badge or athlete bib number will be removed. Only competing athletes and coaches with the proper credentials will be allowed on the infield.

GENERAL PUBLIC ADMISSION:

A daily admission charge of \$15.00 plus admin fee must be purchased by everyone not competing in the Meet.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Each middle school may enter three (3) athletes in the individual events and one (1) relay in the relay events. Dress in School Track Uniform and/or attire for participation in the meet.

The online entry will be open until 11:55 P.M. Monday Night, March 11, 2025.

ELIGIBILITY

This Meet is open to 6th, 7th, and 8th graders ONLY. In accordance with Florida Statute 1006.15(3)(a), a student must maintain a 2.0 on a 4.0 scale to be eligible for interscholastic athletic competition. Duval County Middle Schools that use <u>Aktivate</u> may bring a copy of their eligibility rosters with them. If your school district <u>does not have this system</u>, please complete the *Middle School Eligibility Form* below. Complete all requested information for each participant. All SCHOOLS must turn in your forms during Coaches Check-in at the Clerk of the Course table.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION

A packet will be provided for each coach including your team's performance list and events entered. A Coaches Check-in Tent will be available at the entryway of Visit Jax Track at Hodges Stadium on Friday, March 13th from 10 a.m. to 11: 00 a.m. All coaches must sign in to pick up packets and official badges. These badges will be for coaches only, NO PARENTS or CHAPERONES!

OLYMPIC EXPERIENCE 11:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.

Gates open at 10:00 a.m. The Olympic Experience will <u>BEGIN PROMPTLY AT 11:30 a.m.</u> on the UNF Sports Arena practice field for all registered schools. <u>Schools will be escorted from the Check-in area to the appropriate area on the field.</u>

COACH JAMES DAY DEVELOPMENTAL MIDDLE SCHOOL CLINIC 1:00 p.m.

Students will rotate through six different stations led by clinicians to gain more knowledge in each area of the events. From there, students will be directed to the designated area for warm-ups prior to the Meet.

THE MEET BEGINS PROMPTLY AT 4:00 p.m.
